

## UNMATCHED ACCESS TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT

Aerospace and defense companies choose Arlington, VA to be a part of the most robust aerospace ecosystem in the nation. Anchored by the largest buyer of aerospace goods and services in the world, the Department of Defense, and supported by key defense research agencies like Air Force Office of Scientific Research (AFOSR), Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA) and Office of Naval Research (ONR), the proximity and access Arlington offers is unmatched. Additionally, Arlington is only minutes from federal agencies, including Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Aviation Agency (FAA) and National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA).



## HOME TO INDUSTRY LEADERS

Eight of the top 10 defense contractors maintain a significant presence in Arlington, including corporate headquarters for Boeing and Raytheon. Also headquartered here are Airbus U.S. Space & Defense and Leonardo DRS. These large corporations often serve as prime contractors for major aerospace and defense programs, while providing subcontracting opportunities for small businesses. 
