HIGHER EDUCATION ACCESS AND STRATEGIC INVESTMENTS

Arlington offers access to more than 60 world-class universities and colleges in the Washington, D.C. metro region, including campuses of George Mason University, Virginia Tech, University of Virginia, The George Washington University, Northeastern University and Marymount University within its borders.

Further, Virginia is investing \$2 billion to boost the tech talent pipeline with 31,000 new computer science graduates over 20 years, including at nearby innovation campuses for George Mason and Virginia Tech.

UNPARALLED ACCESS TO A QUALIFIED AND DIVERSE TALENT POOL

Home to approximately 230,000 people, Arlington has a median age of 35 and consistently ranks in the top five best cities to live and for young professional (*Niche.com*). According to CompTIA's Cyberstates 2023 report, the Washington, D.C. Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) ranked in the top quartile of the diversity index for tech talent compared to other MSA's in the United States. In Arlington, 23% of residents are foreign born and a total of 88 languages are spoken by Arlington County Public School students.

VENTURE CAPITAL ACCESS

Venture and M&A activity plays a big role in Arlington's startup ecosystem and high-growth companies. Since 2015, Arlington-based companies have raised over \$2.2 billion in venture capital across 166 deals, and generated over \$17 billion in M&A and IPO activity (*Source: Crunchbase, 2024*).

As Arlington gains national attention as a major innovation hub, the technology sector is taking notice with increased venture capital, accelerator and incubators, talent investments and co-working to support the tech ecosystem in Arlington, VA.
