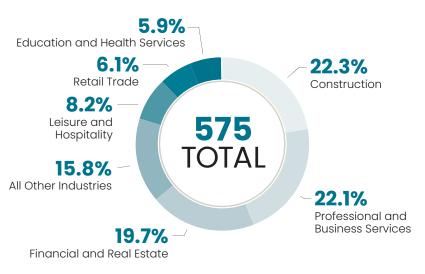

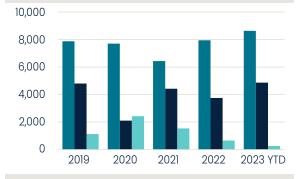
OFFICE SQUARE FEET

ARLINGTON-BASED SHIFT5 RAISES ADDITIONAL \$33M IN FUNDING

Located in Rosslyn, Shift5, the onboard data company, announced it raised \$33 million in additional financing, bringing its Series B round to \$83 million. Led by Moore Strategic Ventures, industry stalwarts across defense and commercial aerospace industries includina Booz Allen Hamilton's corporate venture capital arm, Booz Allen Ventures, and JetBlue Ventures, as well as Teamworthy Ventures, participated in the round, bringing the company's total venture funding to \$108 million.

The fundraise comes amid significant business momentum; in the last year Shift5 more than doubled its annual recurring revenue (ARR), more than doubled its number of customers across Department of Defense (DoD) and commercial aerospace and rail sectors, and grew the rate of its platform deployments on commercial and DoD vehicles and weapon systems by 1,275%.

Shift5's prime location in Arlington, VA allows the company to support multiple branches and combatant commands of the U.S. military, including: U.S. Army, U.S. Navy, U.S. Air Force, U.S. Space Force, and U.S. Special Operations Command.
